14 and under

Own choice – March – 2 parts, any time signature

Open to competitors who have not won a Chanter contest.

N.B. Entrants for Piping excluded from this class

181. SOLO PIPING

Novice Under 18

Open to piping competitors who have not won a Novice piping contest. Competitors may not play in any other piping class.

182. SOLO PIPING - INTERMEDIATE

Under 18

Own choice – March – 4 parts, any time signature

18 and under

Own choice – March, Strathspey and reel – Minimum of 4 parts each.

184. SOLO PIPING (Confined to Angus)

Under 21

Own choice – March – 4 parts, any time signature

AWARD: THE TOM MATHESON CUP

185. PIOBAIREACHD

Under 15 years

Own choice

AWARD: THE GORDON ROGERS SHIELD

N.B. Competitor MUST give name of Piobaireachd and setting chosen on entry form.

186. PIOBAIREACHD

15 and under 18

Own choice

N.B. Competitor MUST give name of Piobaireachd and setting chosen on entry form.

187. SOLO PIPING (Specified Composer)

Under 21

Own Choice – March – 4 parts, any time signature but MUST be a composition by Pipe Major John McColl

19 years and over

Own choice – March, Strathspey and Reel – Minimum of 4 parts each.

189. SOLO PIPING

Under 18

Own Choice – Jig – 4 parts

Own Choice – Jig and Hornpipe – 4 parts each

AWARD: THE IAN KINNEAR CHALICE

191. DRUMMING ON PAD

14 and under

Open to competitors who have never gained a first place in a Drumming on Pad competition.

Own Choice 2-parts March - any time signature

AWARD: ARBROATH FESTIVAL DRUMMING AWARD

192. SIDE DRUMMING

Novice Under 18.

Open to competitors who have never gained a first place in a Novice Drumming competition.

Own Choice four-parts March (any time signature)

AWARD: THE IAN BERRIE TROPHY

193. SIDE DRUMMING - INTERMEDIATE

Under 18.

Open to competitors who have graduated from novice. Competitors in this class can not play in another Side Drumming class.

Own Choice four-parts March (any time signature)

194. SIDE DRUMMING

Under 18 years

Own choice four-parts March (any time signature) and four-parts Strathspey and four-parts Reel.

Own choice four-parts March (any time signature) and four-parts Strathspey and four-parts Reel.

Novice Under 18

Open to competitors who have never gained a first place in a Novice Tenor Drumming competition.

Own Choice 4 parts March (any time signature)

AWARD: THE ROTARY CLUB OF ARBROATH TROPHY

197. TENOR DRUMMING

Under 18

Own Choice 4 parts March (any time signature) and 4 parts Strathspey and four parts Reel.

AWARD: THE MARTEEN NICOLL TROPHY

198. TENOR DRUMMING

18 and over

Own Choice 4 parts March (any time signature) and 4 parts Strathspey and four parts Reel.

AWARD: ARBROATH FESTIVAL DRUMMING AWARD

Note: Drummers should bring their own piper.
